

Potty training at a glance.

If an oops happens

#1) If you catch your puppy in the act a quick tap on the bum and bring them outside immediately.

#2) If you do not manage to catch your puppy and you only find the mess; bring him/her to the mess and tell them no. DO NOT RUB THEIR NOSE IN IT, THIS WILL PROMOTE FEAR.

- For the first few weeks bring treats with you outside and give them a treat and praise them every time they do their business.

- Cut off water 2 hours before bed time to help them sleep through the night.

- Keep them on a food scheduled. They will need to do their business 30 minutes to one hour after eating.

- Puppies under 6 months will want to pee every hour or so.

- Puppies over 6 months to one year about every 2-3 hours.

- Clean floors with a vinegar and water mixture. (1/4 cup vinegar to 1 cup water) to help repel them from wanting to do their business on your floor. (Plus it gives a streak free shine safe on all surfaces including wood and laminate.)
